Center of Excellence, Park City Utah



CENTER OF EXCELLENCE

In March of 2009 we completed the Center of Excellence, a state-of-the-art athletic complex. The 85,000 sq. ft. center was built on five acres just east of Park City in Quinn's Junction at the intersection of U.S. 40 and Utah 248. It is the home for the USSA's elite athletes, a headquarters for the Olympic sports organization, and an educational resource for athletes, coaches, judges and officials.

The project was constructed for the specific purpose of allowing Athletes from the United States to train for future Olympic games. The building blends the best of high-performance athletic facilities. Included are strength-training areas, a gymnasium, ski and snowboarding ramps, trampolines, a nutrition center, an indoor pool with underwater cameras for water aerobics and recovery/rehabilitation facilities. It also features educational areas for athletes, coaches and clubs such as a computer lab, multimedia rooms for performance analysis and equipment workshops, as well as a full sport science lab.

From an electrical standpoint, the building includes a Crestron dimming and control system for lighting, a 100 KW generator for emergency loads and atrium smoke evacuation, turn-key data/communication package, security / access control and site lighting.

The USSA broke ground on the Center in July, 2007. The project was built by Jacobsen Construction.

Thanks to the great team we had on this project, the building was completed within the 20 months schedule. We salute the entire team for their excellent performance.
